10:30-11:20 **Climate Resilience for Historic Sites** presented by Katie Lowe, Preservation Specialist at the Conservation Center for Art and Historic Artifacts (CCAHA). She will present on her work as part of a recent initiative, **CCAHA's Coastal Climate Resiliency Cohort for coastal New Jersey and Delaware.** Specifically, she will discuss climate resiliency for cultural institutions in terms of emergency planning for increasingly dramatic weather patterns and higher annual rainfall, increasingly stressed environmental regulatory systems, and collections-related carbon emissions. Followed by discussion of Bayshore Center at Bivalve living on the front line of climate change, how it affects its historic building and program planning and thoughts on the future based on BCB's facility studies.
